CHANGE IN THE SERVICE CHARGE FOR ONLINE JUDICIAL SALES

Pursuant to 45.035(3) F.S., as amended in 2017, the service charge for online judicial sales must be paid by the applicant filing for an electronic sale date.

Effective immediately, the \$49 service charge (FS 45.035(3)) shall be paid at the time of filing for an electronic sale date on the state e-filing portal. This is in addition to the \$70.00 service charge (FS 45.035(1)) that must be paid from the Real Auction bidder account prior to the sale taking place. Failure to pay either of these fees will lead to the sale being cancelled.
